### Fund Manager's Comments

For the month of June 2017, the NAV of the AKD Index Tracker Fund (AKDITF) decreased by 7.99% versus the benchmark KSE-100 Index that decreased by 7.96%. The fiscal year to date return of the AKD Index Tracker Fund (AKDITF) stood at 20.77% versus the benchmark KSE-100 Index return of 23.24%.

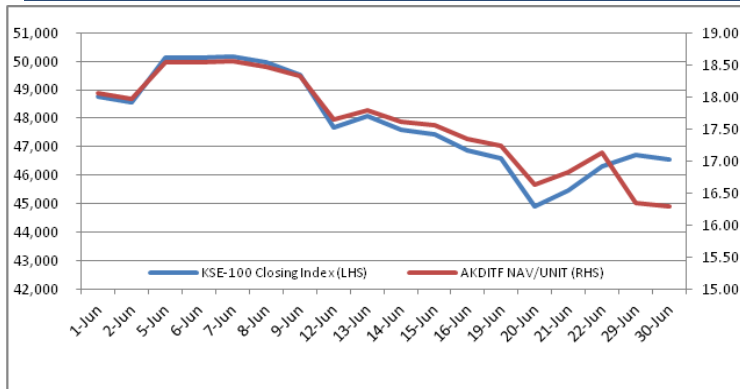
