Fund Manager's Comments

For the month of March'20 the AKD Opportunity Fund (AKDOF) outperformed the benchmark KSE-100 Index. The benchmark KSE-100 Index decreased by 23.04% versus the AKD Opportunity Fund that decreased by 17.28%. Fiscal year to date return stood at -18.07% versus the benchmark KSE-100 Index return of -13.78%.

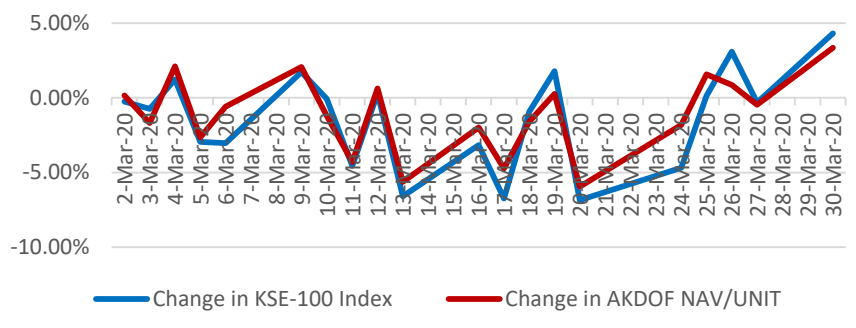
