Fund Manager's Comments

For the month of May'14 the AKD Opportunity Fund (AKDOF) underperformed the benchmark KSE-100 Index. NAV of the AKD Opportunity Fund increased by 2.63% versus the benchmark KSE-100 Index increase of 2.85%. Fiscal year to date return stood at 50.50% versus the benchmark KSE-100 Index return of 41.57%, outperforming the benchmark KSE-100 Index by 8.93%.

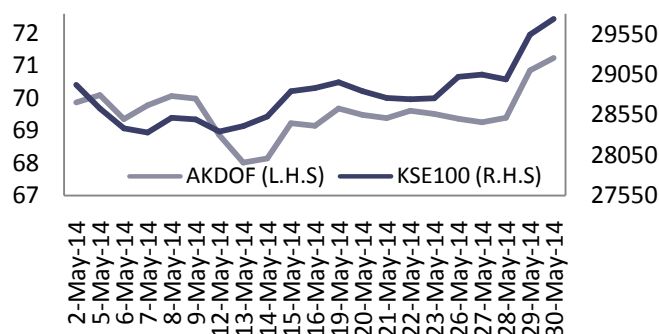
