Fund Manager's Comments

For the month of June'15 the AKD Opportunity Fund (AKDOF) outperformed the benchmark KSE-100 Index. NAV of the AKD Opportunity Fund appreciated by 18.76% versus the benchmark KSE-100 Index that increased by 4.06%. Fiscal year to date return stood at 33.36% versus the benchmark KSE-100 Index return of 16.01%, outperforming the benchmark KSE-100 Index by 17.35%.

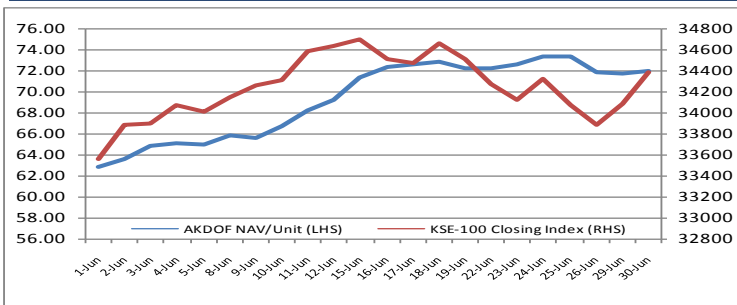
