For the month July'18 the AKD Opportunity Fund (AKDOF) underperformed the benchmark KSE-100 Index. The benchmark KSE-100 Index increased by 1.91% versus the AKD Opportunity Fund that increased by 0.06%. Fiscal year to date return stood at 0.06 % versus the benchmark KSE-100 Index return of 1.91 %, thus unperformed the benchmark KSE-100 Index.

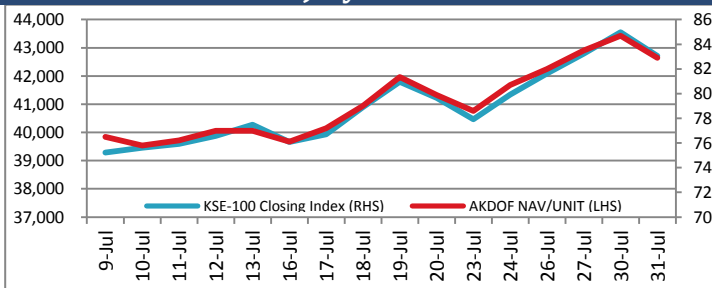
