Fund Manager's Comments

For the month of June'16 the AKD Opportunity Fund (AKDOF) underperformed the benchmark KSE-100 Index. The benchmark KSE-100 Index increased by 4.78% versus the AKD Opportunity Fund that decreased by (0.80) %. Fiscal year to date return stood at 14.13% versus the benchmark KSE-100 Index return of 9.84%, outperforming the benchmark KSE-100 Index by 4.29%.

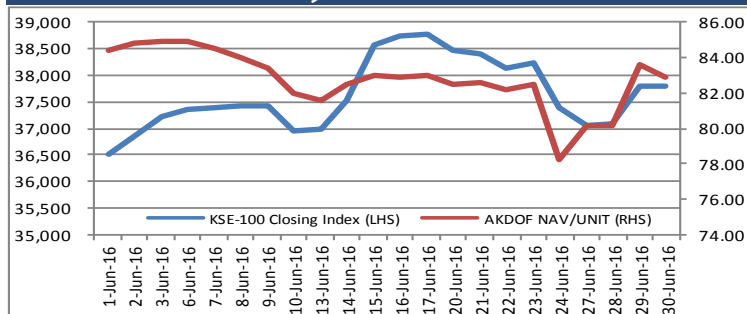
