Fund Manager's Comments

For the month of May'20 the AKD Opportunity Fund (AKDOF) outperformed the benchmark KSE-100 Index. The benchmark KSE-100 Index decreased by 0.53% versus the AKD Opportunity Fund that increased by 10.08%. Fiscal year to date return stood at 3.16% versus the benchmark KSE-100 Index return of 0.09%.

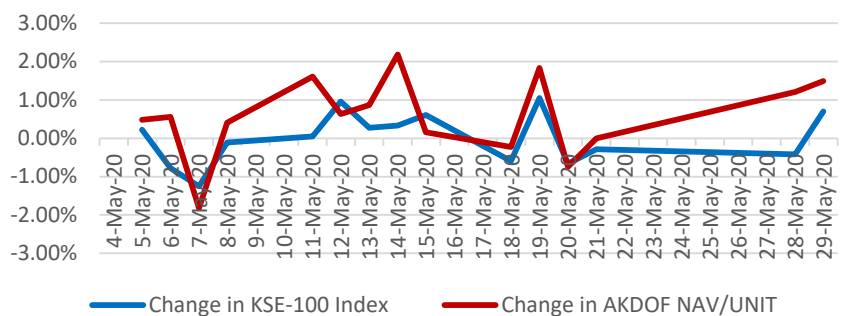
