Fund Manager's Comments

For the month of November'16 the AKD Opportunity Fund (AKDOF) outperformed the benchmark KSE-100 Index. The benchmark KSE-100 Index increased by 6.84% versus the AKD Opportunity Fund that increased by 9.44%. Fiscal year to date return stood at 33.81% versus the benchmark KSE-100 Index return of 12.81%, outperforming the benchmark KSE-100 Index by 21.00%.

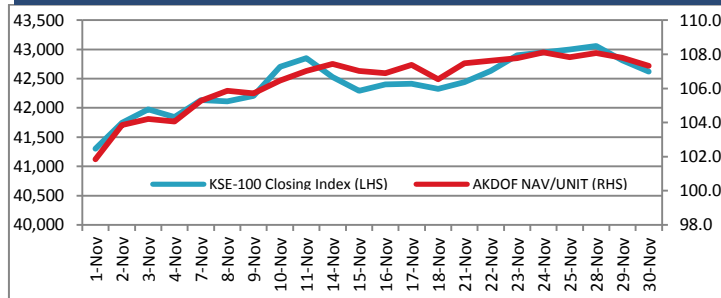
