Fund Manager's Comments

For the month of June'17 the AKD Opportunity Fund (AKDOF) underperformed the benchmark KSE-100 Index. The benchmark KSE-100 Index decreased by 7.96% versus the AKD Opportunity Fund that decreased by 11.24%. Fiscal year to date return stood at 35.56% versus the benchmark KSE-100 Index return of 23.24%, outperforming the benchmark KSE-100 Index by 12.32%.

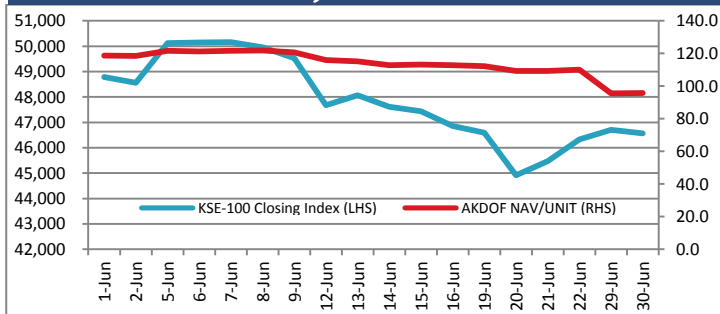
