For the month of September'17 the AKD Opportunity Fund (AKDOF) outperformed the benchmark KSE-100 Index. The benchmark KSE-100 Index increased by 2.92% versus the AKD Opportunity Fund that increased by 3.68%. Fiscal year to date return stood at (4.21) % versus the benchmark KSE-100 Index return of (8.92) %, outperforming the benchmark KSE-100 Index by 4.71%

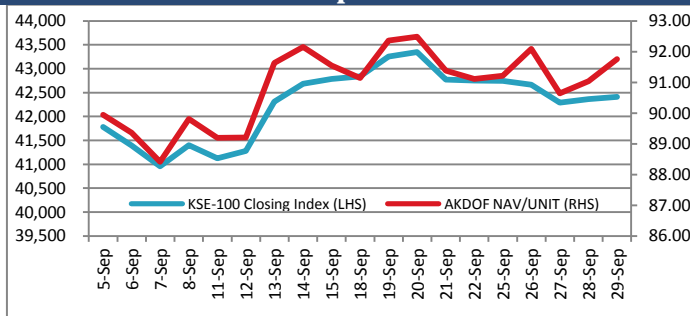
