Fund Manager's Comments

For the month of June 2014, NAV of the Golden Arrow Selected Stocks Fund Ltd. has decreased by 3.09% versus the decrease in benchmark KSE-100 Index of 0.29%. For the fiscal year to date return of the GASSFL stood at 51.67% versus the benchmark KSE-100 Index return of 41.16%, thus significantly outperforming the benchmark KSE-100 Index by 10.51%.

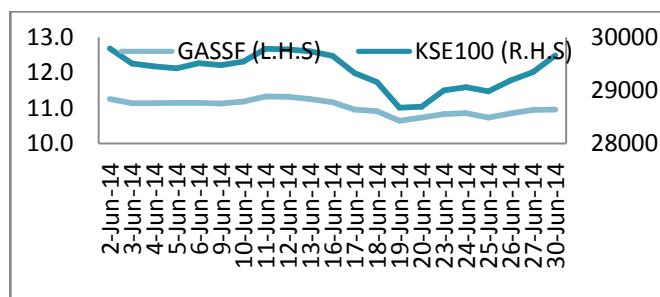
